#### 4. <u>CHAIRMAN'S REPORT</u>

(i) **Gatwick Northern Runway Consultation:** Cllr. Chapman attended the Gatcom meeting at which this consultation was discussed. A response on behalf of Felbridge Parish Council was circulated and approved and has been submitted by the Clerk.

(ii) Surrey County Council Budget Consultation: Information about this consultation had come to the attention of Felbridge Parish Council by chance. No information had been provided by SCC. While the social media post contained links to a number of documents, the headline was that SCC are planning a 4.5% increase in their precept for the financial year 2022-2023. It was considered that residents would not be able to easily access this information and that communication had been poor. <u>Action</u>: Clerk to include on the Agenda for the next Planning Meeting so a formal response could be circulated and approved. <u>Action</u>: Clerk to share information on the Parish Council Facebook page.

# 7. DISTRICT COUNCILLOR REPORT

Cllr. Moore reported that she had received an email from a resident concerned about development of the MSDC SA19 site off Crawley Down Road and the lack of funding for the Star Junction.

**Vehicle Activated Sign, Woodcock Hill**: Cllr. King reported that the sign did not appear to be working. **Action**: Clerk to report to Surrey Highways

**Football Club**: Cllr. King has reported damaged guttering and car park issues to TDC **Pavements**: Cllrs. Huntington and McBryde have conducted a survey of pavements along the A22 and provided information and photographs for the Clerk so a map can be prepared for contractors who will be asked to clear the worst areas. A similar survey will be conducted on the A264 and Crawley Down Road. **Action**: Clerk to progress.

## (i) Applications in Felbridge

# Applications considered at the full Parish Council meeting:

## 2021/1903 Chester Lodge, Woodcock Hill, Felbridge, RH19 2RD

**Resolved**: Felbridge Parish Council are concerned about this latest application for Chester Lodge. Again the application drawings show a very small red area lined, yet the applicant is the same as that for the last applications. The area they stated they had an interest over on the previous application is not red lined in this application. This hides the overall scale of their site and the ever growing built form upon it. Whilst it is accepted that each application is for relatively small additions, there appears to have been no consideration by Tandridge District Council of the cumulative impact upon the openness of the Green Belt. The graphic below shows the built footprint changes from 2005 to 2021. This obviously does not show the significant increase in hardstanding or take any account of built volume which is the criteria used to control the cumulative impact of domestic properties extensions within the Green Belt. While Felbridge Parish Council supports rural businesses, there is also a responsibility to protect the Green Belt.

# 2021/1503 Glenmore, West Park Road, Copthorne, RH10 3EX

**Resolved**: Felbridge Parish Council consider there to be insufficient information provided to enable councillors to comment on this application. The Design and Access statement is misleading; there is reference to a small ground floor extension and no clear information on the proposed extension. Councillors are disappointed that an application of this poor quality should have been validated and would welcome the opportunity to consider this application at a future date should the required full documentation be provided.

#### 2021/1958 Park Farm, Woodcock Hill, Felbridge, RH19 2RB (Listed Building Consent)

**Noted**: When the Planning Officer was asked why there had been a delay in determining this application, their response was that this was due in part to the Historic Buildings Advisor not yet responding. This notification, issued shortly afterwards, indicates that the Historic Buildings element to this application had not been progressed when the application was initially submitted.

#### (ii) Applications Received by Neighbouring Authorities

50 bed Care Home including means of access and parking

(iii) **MSDC Playground and Sport**: An officer from MSDC has approached the Clerk regarding an expected planning application for 200 houses off Crawley Down Road which is supported by MSDC. Even though any such application would be opposed by Felbridge Parish Council, their funding system means that funding for facilities such as play and sport need to be included at the start of any application. <u>Action</u>: Clerk to respond on behalf of Felbridge Parish Council.

# 14. <u>CLERK'S REPORT</u>

(i) **Correspondence:** Further complaints from resident regarding the damaged road surface near 11a Crawley Down Road. Highways response to Felbridge Parish Council was that the works would be completed but were not considered urgent. The resident has not made a report to Surrey Highways.
