2025/962 The Stables, Wards Farm, London Road, Felbridge, Surrey, RH19 2QZ

Erection of up to 9 dwellings (permission in principle)

2025/747 Larksfield, Domewood, Copthorne, Surrey, RH10 3HD

Erection of replacement dwelling together with associated boundary works.

2025/781 Dormer Cottage, Woodcock Hill, Felbridge, Surrey, RH19 2RD

Demolition of existing property and erection of replacement dwelling.

T1) Common Oak – fell and treat stump to prevent regrowth

2025/969/TPO Lok Lum, Domewood, Copthorne, Crawley, Surrey, RH10 3HD

T1) Oak – reduce the crown all round by approx. 2m leaving height of approx. 13m - reduce the height by approx. 2.5m leaving height of approx. 10m to allow more light into the garden

T2) Birch – reduce the height by approx. 2.5m height leaving height of approx. 10m to allow more light into the garden

T3) Birch – reduce height by approx. 2.5m to leave height of approx. 10m to allow more light into the garden.

2025/1032/TPO 1 Glendale, Felbridge, East Grinstead, Surrey, RH19 2QN

T1) - Beech - Limb overhanging Laurel hedge on the right-hand side of front garden cut back to fence line. To include small limb over flower bed.

T2) - Yew situated in front garden - Laterals growing towards house reduce by 2m.

2025/975/TPO Pinewood, Herons Lea, Copthorne, Crawley, RH10 3HE

T9) Oak - Raise canopy to 5m above ground level.

T11) Oak - Raise canopy to 5m above ground level, crown thin by 30%, remove deadwood, strip ivy.

T15) - Silver Birch - Raise canopy to 5m above ground level and crown thin by 20%.

T16) - Pine - Crown clean and thin, raise lower canopy; reduce limb weighting over road.

T17) - Pine - Crown clean and thin; raise lower canopy.

T25) - Pine - Fell and replace with suitable specimen.

T28) - Pine - Reduce height by 5 metres, reduce limb weighting over neighbouring property to the east.
